
Windows 7, 8, and 8.1 Software Inventory


The presentation shows downloading a Windows batch file to generate a list of all installed programs. The batch file attempts to find all programs on the local computer. The generated list is very long and really needs to be sorted in a spreadsheet or a database program.


There are several methods of installing a program in Windows. The list of installed programs found in the Control Panel only shows programs installed one way. The batch file collects information from the Windows registry, the Control Panel installed programs list, and a limited search for programs that do not need installation. All of this information is put in a text file.


This presentation does not discuss the process of filtering the software list.


